Cedar will vary in colour from light pink to dark chocolate brown.

Cedar will naturally weather, it will turn an attractive, silvery-grey colour if left untreated or use an UV oil or stain to sustain its colour.

Naturally lightweight makes it easy to handle whilst retaining structural rigidity.



Slow grown Canadian timber

Canadian Western Red Cedar is much slower grown than British Western Red Cedar resulting in a denser, darker wood with a more varied colour palette.

Easy to work with, easy to install

Skyline Premium Western Red Cedar Slats are planed on all four sides with a small radius on four corners for a beautiful aesthetic look and to avoid thinning of coatings on the edges if an oil or stain is applied.

Available in 1.83m and 2.13m packs (16 pieces per pack), slats are easy to trim to required final or desired length. As a guide you'll require 2 packs of 6ft slats to cover a 6ft (1830mm) x 6ft (1830mm) area.

Western Red Cedar is naturally durable, making the wood long-lasting without the need for additional treatment.

Standard Softwood treated posts can be used when using the slats for fencing.

We recommend stainless steel countersunk screws or annular ring nails for fixing.
